We are ready for another fun and exciting summer at the Valley Y summer day camp! You can expect plenty of the annual favorites like Kid's Dance Classes, YMCA 360, Yoga, Girl Scouts, Summer Reading, and Swimming at the Woodruff Family YMCA! You can also expect some new additions to our camp like Giant Field Games and planting at our Garden. Our Camp is Located at 4 Fourth St in Ansonia. The field will be used for flag football, soccer and kickball games. The kids will be able to go to the park and use the playground as well as getting to play basketball on the courts.

The Valley YMCA has a community garden that we take care of yearly. During camp the campers will go and plant food for members in the community. We plant, clean and water the garden all summer to make sure it is ready for the community members to take the food we grow. The campers are able to pick some of the veggies so that we can try it for a healthy snack.

Our counselors are specially chosen using in-person interviews, reference checks and training. They are educators, future teachers and local students with a genuine interest in working with children. Your children may already know them from other Y programs. At least 80% are 18 years old and older. After receiving an average of 40 hours of training in safety, positive behavior management and activity planning, they are ready to help campers make new friends and do everything possible to ensure a fun summer.

The Y works with children of all abilities. If your child requires special accommodations (social, behavioral, medical) please contact the Camp Director. The Y strives to provide each camper with an optimal summer experience but can not guarantee a specific counselor or camp group.
