## FAIRFIELD YMCA SUMMER CAMP

The center of day camp is the campers. There are few environments as special as summer camp. Kids unite to become their own community as they learn to be independent and how to contribute through group interaction during physical, social, and educational activities.

Day Camp will offer camper's new experiences mixed with old camp favorites each week. Campers thrive during various daily activities including organized games, arts and crafts projects, exciting field trips and swimming.

Many activities will focus on the YMCA character Values of Respect, Responsibility, Honesty and Caring. Each Week our Explorers and Adventures group will get to experience one of our great beaches right here in Fairfield! Our Greenhorn group will go to Sandcastle Playground once a week.

At the Y, we make kids feel welcome and supported. Our counselors are specially chosen using in-person interviews, reference checks and training. They are educators, recreation specialists, future teachers and local students with a genuine interest in working with children. Your children may already know them from other Y programs and after school care. At least eighty percent, are 18 years old and older. After receiving an average of 40 hours of training in safety, positive behavior management and activity planning, they are ready to help campers make new friends and do everything possible to ensure a fun summer.

Camp is available to all children. The Y will work with children of all abilities. If your child requires special accommodations (social, behavioral, medical) please contact the camp director. The Y strives to provide each camper with an optimal summer experience but can not guarantee a specific counselor or camp group.

**The Y has child care programs available from the day school ends until it begins again! Ask about Y Vacation Club, Y Fun Club, Before and After school programs and Preschool (for the little ones.)**

## WHAT TO KNOW BEFORE YOU GO!

All Preschool summer programs begin at 9:00am. Sunshine Club ends at noon, Discovery ends at 1:00pm and Badakookala and Beach Club end at 3:00pm.

**Summer Preschool Sunshine and Discovery Club** are held at the Y. Sunshine Club can pick from 2 (T/TH), 3 (MWF), and 5 (M-F) day per a week. Discovery PM care ends at 4pm.

**Camp Badakookala:** AM Care Program begins at 7:30am and PM Care ends at 6:00pm. Campers begin their day at Sherman Elementary School at 9:00am from 6/20/2022 to 8/19/2022. PM Care Campers will be bussed to the Fairfield Y for pick up by 6pm.

State regulations requires that a fully completed and signed health form must be on file in the camp office for each camper. Health forms are due no later than one week prior to the first day of camp. No camper will be allowed to attend camp without a current completed form. A physical within the past two years is required with this years signature and date from your child's physician.

## FAIRFIELD YMCA DAY CAMPS

### SUNSHINE CLUB

Summer fun for 2 year old's. A gentle introduction to group activities for the first time participant. Children will participate in circle time, arts and crafts, water play, outdoor play, and music. Choose between 2, 3, and 5 days a week to fit your schedule. Each week is themed and there will be a special day celebrating the theme of the week. Child must be two by the time they join the club.

### DISCOVERY CAMP

Summer fun for 3 and 4 year old's. Safe supervised fun with caring and responsible staff. Each session, campers swim, do arts and crafts, creative play, outdoor play, water play, make friends and have lots of fun! Each week is themed and there will be a special day celebrating the theme.

### BEACH CLUB

Beach Club is a wonderful opportunity for children to make friends and enjoy the beautiful costal area we are blessed to live in. Participants get lots of exercise and have fun in the water, sand, and sun; a perfect combination of what we all need now more then ever! The program runs Monday through Friday 9am to 3pm with before care available from 8am and after care available until 6pm There is never a dull moment as we swim, fish, clam, kayak, and paddleboard. Participants should be strong swimmers having the ability to swim 25 yards without any floatation, be comfortable in open water, as well as treading and swimming in deep water. Participants will need to bring their energy and endurance as it is a very physical program. Join us as we explore Fairfield's five beautiful beaches and estuaries, as well as form friendships that will last a lifetime.

### HALF DAY SWIM

In this intensive swim lesson program the children learn to swim and be safe in and around the water. The program is designed for youth ages 3-10 years and offered in morning and afternoon. Children will gain skills and confidence while having fun. Children will participate in two 45 minute swim lessons each day, enjoy a healthy snack, and play outside weather permitting. Sessions run weekly from June to August, morning 9am to 12pm and afternoons 1pm to 4pm.
